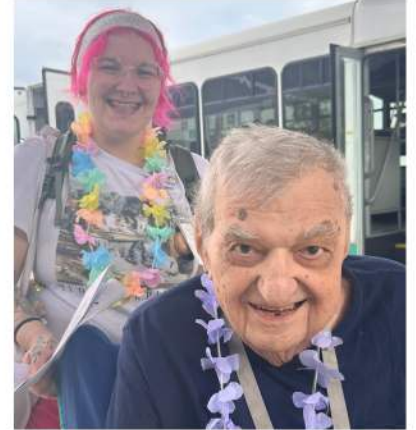

More information will be shared in the coming months.

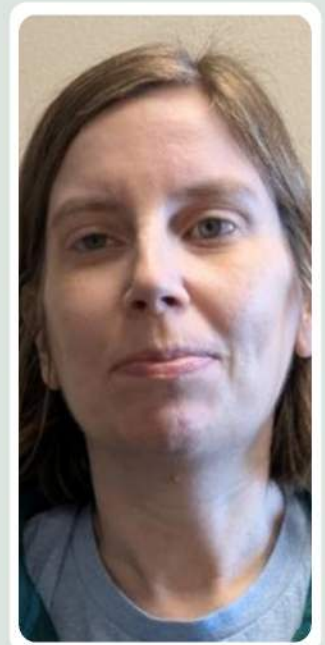
